The idea for this project is collaboration between the Alianza Americana in Leon, Nicaragua, Amigos de la Policia, Granada, Nicaragua, Albert Schweitzer Institute at Quinnipiac University, Partners International Foundation and the Fairfield Police Department. We will provide leadership training for a small group of police officers in Granada, Nicaragua. The contact in Granada is an organization called Amigos de la Policia (Friends of the Police). We have been in contact with this organization for over a year and the lead contact is an American ex-pat living in Granada, Darrell Bushnell. The training will be facilitated by Dr. Oscar Aragon, Director of Alianza Americana. The need for this leadership training has been identified by the contact at Amigos de la Policia and the Chief of the Police Department in Granada, Nicaragua. We hope to begin the program as a pilot and have about 6-8 participants during the first training and hopefully make this an annual event.
