FORT BENNING SOLDIERS RECEIVE A SURPRISE VISIT FROM FAMOUS AUTHOR ROBIN MOORE

COLUMBUS, Georgia., 27 Oct 2001— Hundreds of the Fort Benning's initial entry soldiers jammed the Target Technologies Display in the EXPO CENTER at the Buick Challenge Golf Tournament in Callaway Gardens during Military Appreciation Day this weekend to meet author Robin Moore.
